Christopher Fulcher is the Co-Director of the Center for Applied Research and Environmental Systems at the University of Missouri-Columbia. Dr. Fulcher's research focuses on integrating emerging computer technologies including geographic information systems, data visualization, and Internet accessibility that help communities, policy makers, and service providers make more informed decisions. His research focuses on using geographic information technologies to examine vulnerable populations and access to health and human services. Specifically, these technologies help vulnerable populations make more informed decisions regarding access, equity, and allocation of resources.



Dr. Fulcher received his B.S. in Agricultural Engineering at Texas A&M University in 1984 and his M.S. in Agricultural Economics at Texas A&M in 1985. He completed his PhD in Agricultural Economics at the University of Missouri in 1996. In 2005 Dr. Fulcher completed his National Library of Medicine Post Doctoral Health Informatics Fellowship at the University of Missouri. Dr. Fulcher also serves as a faculty member in the Rural Sociology Department and the Harry S Truman School of Public Affairs.
